New exhibition & Invitation to the press conference (27.10. // 11 a.m.) »Marijke van Warmerdam: Then, now, and then« Opening: 28.10.2022, 7 p.m. Runtime: 29.10.2022 - 05.02.2023

Under the title »Marijke van Warmerdam. Then, now, and then« fourteen new film loops created by Dutch artist Marijke van Warmerdam during a residency in Rome in 2017 and subsequent visits to the Italian capital will be presented at the ZKM | Karlsruhe from October 28, 2022.

Marijke van Warmerdam first attracted international attention at the Venice Biennale in 1995 with her short film loops. In these films she portrayed the beauty of simple movements and everyday actions. As she says herself: »Art can give life a twist, and the other way around.« The films reveal traces of the dynamism of the Baroque era in today's Rome, in which the artist captures people jogging, gesticulating in traffic, shopping, and lovers on a bridge. With her keen eye for abstract image qualities, Van Warmerdam finds the essence of the subject she has filmed, which was initially a trivial matter.

Distance and proximity, visibility and invisibility, movement and rotation alternate. Camerawork, lighting, editing, everything in the films is designed to make the restless whirls of the Baroque visible. At any moment of its constant flow – day, dawn and night – the camera is moving together with bikers, car drivers, and the Tiber. Van Warmerdam celebrates the hidden order of chance. In the film loops the sounds of the city play a vital role. In fact, the soundtracks provide a connecting tissue between the fourteen films. A long screen print on paper – a newly produced work »Timeline« – connects the films in a more graphic way.

In addition to the Venice Biennale, Marijke van Warmerdam has participated in numerous international exhibitions, including the Sydney, Berlin and Gwangju Biennials, and documenta X. She has had major solo exhibitions at the Van Abbemuseum in Eindhoven, the ICA in Boston, MAC in Marseille and The State Hermitage Museum in St. Petersburg. A retrospective of her work has been shown at Museum Boijmans Van Beuningen in Rotterdam, Serralves Museum of Contemporary Art in Porto and the Kunsthalle Düsseldorf. Van Warmerdam is a regular advisor at the Rijksakademie van beeldende kunsten in Amsterdam and Professor of Art at the State Academy of
